

BCLS 1000 BOOKS before KINDERGARTEN

How it works:

The Berkeley County Library System encourages families to read at least 1,000 books with their children before they enter kindergarten.

Who is eligible?

Any child from birth to the day they enter kindergarten.

How does it work?

Stop by any Berkeley County Library and pick up your first reading log or go online to <https://berkeleylibrarysc.org/1000books>. You will use the log to record 100 books at a time. You will have a choice of logs:

1. A list that you may write down the names of the books or;
2. A list that you may check off or color a book for every book read.

Once you have completed 100 books, please go to <https://berkeleylibrarysc.libwizard.com/1000Books> to log your books or you may bring your log to the library and we will log your books and you may pick up a new log for the next 100 books.

How long does it take to reach 1,000 Books?

1 book per day x 3 years = 1,095 books

10 books per week x 2 years = 1,040 books

3 books per day x 1 year = 1,095 books

What happens when we complete 1,000 books?

Your child will receive a certificate and a book. They may also get their picture taken and posted on the Library's Facebook page.
